We will be applying for more funding in the near future, so that we can hire personnel to clear the flagged trails, during the summer of 2005.

We hope to see everyone at the Willmore Wilderness Winter Wingding in Grande Prairie on November 27,

2004. For those of you who are closer to Edmonton, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Willmore Wilderness Fundraiser will be held at the Coast Terrace Inn on April 9, 2005. We really need your support at these events, so mark your calendars.

We are starting right away with other fund raising activities. Our target is to raise \$15,000.00 to run a youth focused Trapper Education Program and a 10-day Cowboy School in the spring of 2005. The Cowboy School will have a strong youth focus and will include a 10-day colt starting clinic. Larry Nelles is the instructor for the advanced horsemanship and colt clinic. Larry grew up in Jasper Alberta in the 1940's. He was the son of a Jasper Park Warden and grew up with horses in a wilderness



environment. Larry has become an internationally renowned horsemanship trainer. He teaches in both the USA and western Canada. We are also looking for corporate financing to support these programs.

All in all, we have a lot of work cut out for us and we really need everyone's support.
